Authorisation holders must continue to comply with all the conditions of the authorisation until such time as an approval to suspend a condition is granted. To avoid potential compliance action by the Department, authorisation holders should lodge applications to suspend conditions in a timeframe that allows adequate time for the processing and determination of the application by the Department.

A condition that is prescribed by the Mining Regulation 2016 cannot be suspended.
