

Schedule of fees for licences, plant design and item of plant registrations

An application for a licence under Part 9, or a plant design or item of plant registration specified in clause 177 of the Work Health and Safety (Mines and Petroleum Sites) Regulation 2014, must be accompanied by a fee. The fees applicable are set out in the schedule below.

Please refer to the relevant application form for instructions on how to make payment. Your application will not be processed until the correct payment is made.

Application for registration of item of plant	\$71.50
Application for renewal of item of plant	\$71.50
Each additional item submitted by an applicant at the same address, owned by the same applicant and included in the same application form	\$2.00

Licence

Fees for licences are required and determined under clause 155(2) of the Work Health and Safety (Mines and Petroleum Sites) Regulation 2014

Type of application	Fee
Overhauling, repairing or modifying activities that may affect the explosion-protection properties of explosion-protected plant – electrical plant	\$900
Overhauling, repairing or modifying activities that may affect the explosion-protection properties of explosion-protected plant – diesel engine systems	\$900
Repairing of flexible reeling, feeder or trailing cables for use in a hazardous zone	\$1700
Undertaking a polymeric process	\$900
Sampling or analysing of diesel engine exhaust	\$900
Sampling or analysing airborne dust	\$900
