



## Offsite disposal of flowback water from AGL's Waukivory Pilot Project

Flowback water is the water that returns to the surface after hydraulic fracturing has been completed. This water has high salinity levels that are not suitable for most treatment facilities.

Under the conditions of its licence, AGL must transport this flowback water to a facility licensed and approved by the Environment Protection Authority (EPA). Currently, AGL has contracted Worth Recycling to transport flowback water from the Waukivory Project to Worth's Windsor facilities.

The management, transport and disposal of the waste water will follow the same waste regulations as any industrial process that generates waste.
